

COVID-19, POLICY FOR VISITORS

Irrigo Centre Ltd is committed to ensuring a safe and healthy work environment for its employees, and visitors.

The emphasis of this policy is on the management of health and safety in relation to potential exposure to the COVID-19 virus. Irrigo Centre Ltd recognises that successful health and safety management is best achieved through transparent information sharing and good faith co-operation between all workplace participants.

Visitors to our Premises

The risk assessment undertaken by Irrigo Centre Ltd has determined the nature of the services that Irrigo Centre Ltd provides and the environment that Irrigo Centre Ltd operates within (i.e., a small team who engage with a medium - high number of individuals across our business community daily) inherently presents a medium-to-high risk of exposure and transmission of COVID-19.

Irrigo Centre Ltd has concluded that the application of controls, such as requiring the use of face coverings, hand washing and personal hygiene regimes, and social distancing will not be sufficiently effective to reduce this risk to tolerable levels. Therefore, the only reasonably practicable way to reduce the risk to tolerable levels for all employees and visitors to Irrigo Centre Ltd, is to require all employees and visitors (including but not limited to members, Board members, clients, contractors, and service providers) to be fully vaccinated when accessing our premises.

On arrival visitors will be required to:

- Sign/Scan in
- Present proof of vaccination via a COVID-19 Vaccine Pass
- Follow all applicable COVID-19 protocols and restrictions based on the highest COVID-19 Protection Framework level that applies to where you are from and the Canterbury region.

By attending our premises, you acknowledge that you do not have any cold or flu like symptoms at the time of attending and will follow all instructions of Irrigo Centre Ltd employees in relation to COVID-19 regulations, which may include but is not limited to appropriate social distancing, mask wearing, and signing/scanning in.

Visitors who experience cold or flu-like symptoms (irrespective of them being related to or associated with COVID-19) must not enter our premises. If such symptoms develop while on our premises, you are required to advise us and may be required to leave our premises. Symptomatic visitors must not attend our premises until such time that they are deemed safe to return in accordance with the relevant Ministry of Health New Zealand guidelines.

Irrigo Centre Ltd will follow all Government requirements and guidance in respect to vaccine passes. This will include requiring anyone entering our premises, to produce their vaccine passes. We confirm that Irrigo Centre Ltd team members visiting your premises are fully vaccinated and will follow all external business' COVID-19 protocols including any requirement to present proof of vaccination on arrival.

This policy covers the Irrigo tenancy of 326 Burnett Street, as such, any tenants, their visitors, contractors, or employees must comply with the Irrigo Policy.

Irrigo Centre Ltd team members remain available to meet with any members or clients virtually.

Irrigo Centre Ltd is entitled to amend this policy at its sole discretion and in accordance with regulatory and/or other developments from time to time.
